

Financial Grants

- We offer over \$400,000 in financial aid to 72% of the student body.
- The largest amount of financial aid awarded is in the form of grants which are based solely on need.
- Financial need is based on family income, expenditures, number of children in the family and other parochial tuition costs incurred.
- Students who receive named scholarships are also eligible for grants.
- Grants range from \$100-\$1,500 depending on need.

All grants are applied for using the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment program. This is an independent company that processes the application and supporting documentation and produces a Needs Assessment report for the school. This enables us to be sure that our awards are distributed in the most equitable way possible. The application can **ONLY** be completed online. Assistance in completing the forms is available from the Business Office, or directly from the FACTS Customer Service Center. There is a \$25 fee to apply for the grant assessment.

Students are notified in March, of any financial aid awarded.

Fr. John Stites Grant

Families with exceptional need who do not receive adequate aid through the regular financial aid process are encouraged to apply for the Fr. John Stites Grant. This application should be made after you have received notification of any scholarships and financial grants that have been awarded.

The Stites Grant is a partnership between the family and CSHS. It is vital that recipients of these scholarships are able to demonstrate a commitment to their faith, commitment to the mission of Cardinal Stritch High School, and embrace Christ's invitation to be stewards.

Please note that special assistance will only be considered AFTER the family has completed the regular grant application procedures. Call 419-693-0465 to set up an appointment.

Tuition Payments

All tuition is due by an announced deadline each year. By this deadline, each family shall have on file a Tuition Planning Date Sheet (TPDS) that indicates how tuition will be paid. The TPDS outlines the various payment plans available through FACTS, the tuition management company that handles all outstanding tuition accounts. Anyone who does not pay tuition in full must opt for one of the FACTS programs.

The FACTS program offers a wide variety of payment options including automatic monthly payments and credit card payments. Detailed information on the FACTS programs is available from the Business Office at school.

“Stewardship Scholarship”

Cardinal Stritch High School values the students who live their faith. We are happy to announce a new scholarship that recognizes those attributes. Therefore, beginning with the 2010-11 school year, the following will be offered to incoming freshmen students.

10 — \$2,000 Scholarships

- Recipient must be a regular altar server, member of their youth ministry program, or involved in other reoccurring specified parish activities.
- Recipient must have their pastor write a letter of recommendation to the President of CSHS specifying the applicant’s involvement.
- Recipient will be expected to be an active member of the Spiritual Life Committee and maintain a spirit of stewardship throughout their high school years.
- Scholarships are renewable at \$500 per year for three additional years, provided each student maintains no less than a “B” average in Theology.



The Stritch Legacy Program was established to help students of Stritch Family members. The Legacy award is a renewable \$1,000.00 scholarship exclusively for the children of CSHS alumni. Unfortunately, stepchildren of alumni are not eligible for this award. Families can apply for the Legacy Scholarship by completing a Scholarship Application.

Named Scholarships

- Recipient must have a strong academic work ethic and be an incoming freshman in financial need.

1 — \$1,000 Scholarship

- An individual who shows artistic promise and has a desire to develop that talent at Cardinal Stritch High School.

BARBARA (HERMAN ‘76) CORBIN

1 — \$500 Scholarship

- Recipient must be an incoming freshman who is an active parishioner at Sacred Heart Parish and in financial need.

DORIS & JOSEPH RAJNER

1 — \$500 Scholarship (renewable for three years)

- Recipient must be an incoming freshman in financial need.
- Recipient must demonstrate involvement in his/her parish, school or community, and maintain good academic standing. Special consideration will be given to students who attended the former Holy Rosary School.

FRANK SR. & RUTH MANNING

1 — \$1,000 Scholarship

- Recipient must be an incoming freshman in financial need.

JEAN FOX

1 — \$1,000 Scholarship

- Recipient should be an incoming freshman in financial need.
- Recipient should be committed to a strong work ethic in the Stritch spirit of being stewards.

2 — \$500 Scholarships

- Recipients should be incoming freshmen in financial need.
- All possible applications are forwarded on to the Vieth family for review and selection.

1 — \$300 Scholarship

- Recipient should be an incoming freshman from St. Ignatius Parish, if possible, or as a second choice from St. Jerome Parish.

RICHARD L. DAVENPORT

1 — \$500 Scholarship

- Recipient should be from St. Rose, Perrysburg, or as indicated by the Davenport Family. Interested families should contact the St. Rose School Principal for an application.

LILLIAN D. METZGER

1 — \$5,000 Scholarship

- Recipient must be an incoming freshman in financial need, a member of an East side parish, and complete a written essay.
- Scholarship is renewable at \$1,250 per year for three additional years, as long as the student maintains a 3.0 GPA.

These scholarships are non-renewable unless specifically stated. Scholarship applications are available from the school beginning at Open House.
